

TIPPING Tipping is not obligatory, but good service can be rewarded.

ELECTRICITY 220 volts AC (50 Hz), type C & F sockets with two round pins

TIME ZONE Central European Time UTC +1 (UTC+2 during daylight saving time)

BAGGAGE Included 1 suitcase 23kg & 1 piece of hand luggage per person

SAFETY A very safe region to visit

CREDIT CARDS Accepted in most cases

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE A representative from BDM will greet you at the airport and transfer to hotel.

MUST TRY FOOD Smørrebrød, Pickled Herring, Frikadeller (Meatballs), Wienerbrød (Danish pastry), Akvavit Snaps, salt liquorice, hotdog

NATIONAL DISH Stegt flæsk - pieces of pork, fried until crisp, and then served with boiled potatoes and parsley sauce.

Denmark is a Nordic country and the southernmost of the Scandinavian nations. Denmark is considered to be one of the most economically and socially developed countries in the world.

It is the oldest monarchy in the world.

Often comes out near the top of global surveys on liveability and happiness.

Is a pioneer in promoting sustainability. To the Danes, sustainability is a holistic approach that includes renewable energy, water management, waste recycling, and green transportation including the bicycling culture. Nine out of ten people in Denmark own a bike. Danes cycle 1.6 km a day on average

Denmark has some of the world's lowest income inequality. Women play a prominent role in business, while men get involved in childraising.

The country legalised same-sex marriage in 2012, and same-sex partners are treated the same as opposite-sex partners before the law.
