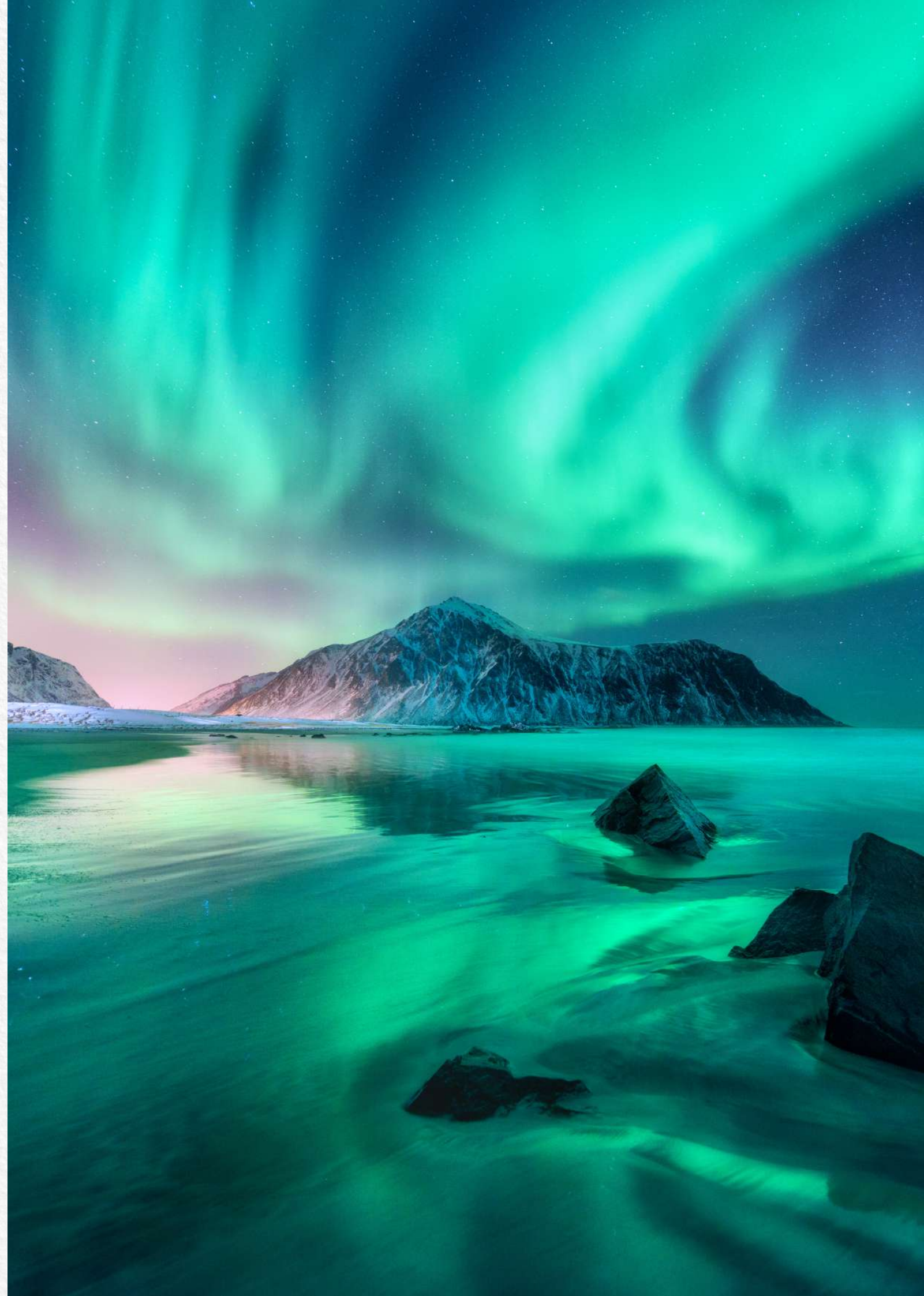

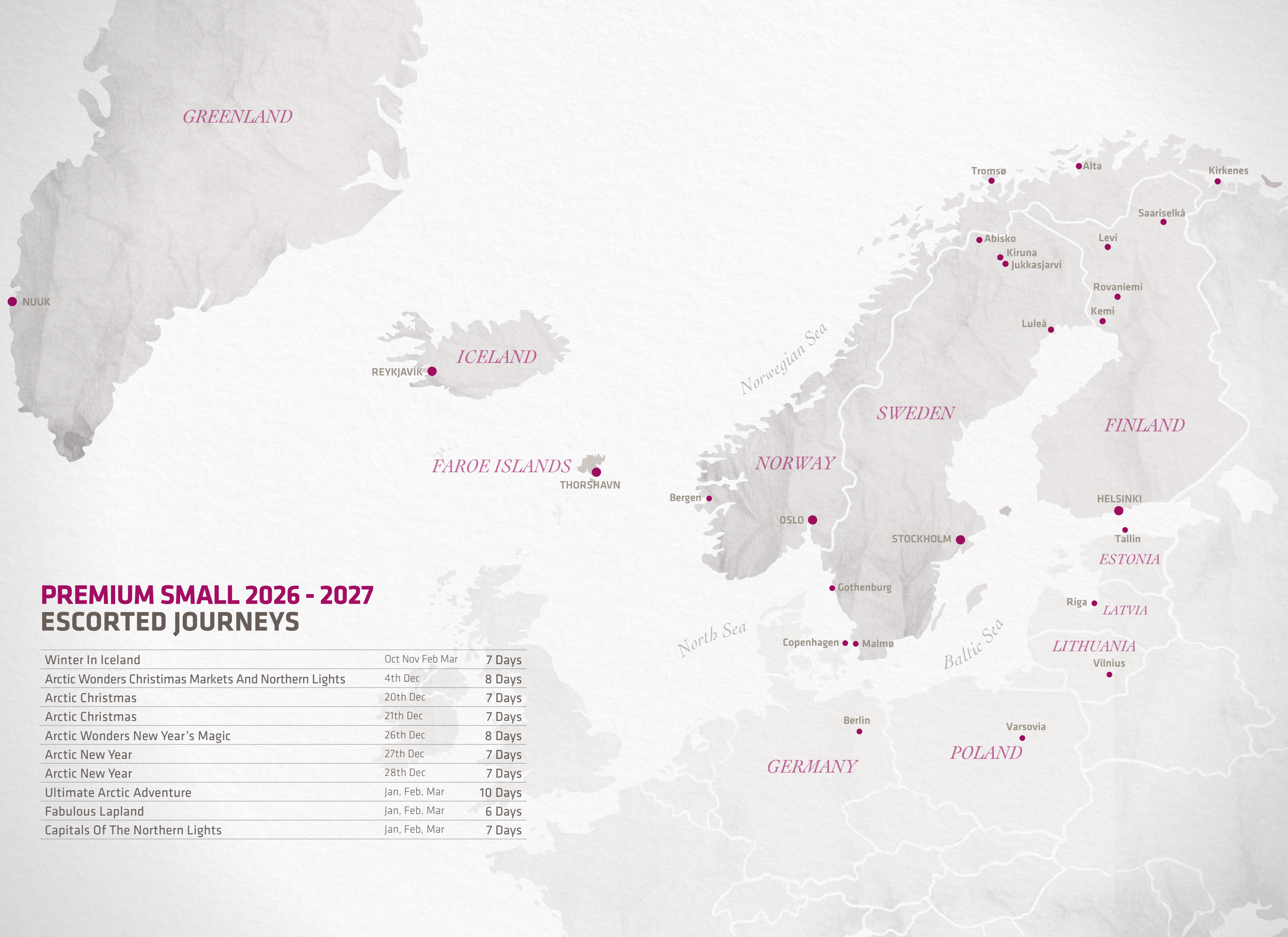

The experience begins at Reykjavík’s Old Harbour, from where we will set sail toward calmer waters, just 15–20 minutes away, far from the city lights and in a privileged spot for observing this natural phenomenon.

During the journey, your guide will share fascinating insights into the science behind the Northern Lights, along with stories and myths that different cultures have created around these magical lights. A crew member will be taking photos throughout the tour so that you can fully enjoy the moment; if you would like help adjusting your camera, they will be happy to assist you.

IMPORTANT: *When the Northern Lights forecast is favorable but the wind conditions are too strong for sailing, guests will be taken by bus for the Northern Lights tour.*

If the Northern Lights are not seen, a second opportunity to take the boat tour will be offered on day 6, at no additional cost.

Meet your guide in the hotel lobby and depart for a full-day excursion. Our first stop will be Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site where history and geology intertwine in a truly exceptional way. Here, you will have the opportunity to walk through the Rift Valley, where the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates drift apart,



forming a landscape unlike any other in the world. Thingvellir is also of great historical importance: it is the birthplace of the Alþingi, the world’s first democratic parliament, established more than a thousand years ago.

The journey continues to Friðheimar including lunch. Afterwards, we will visit the Geysir geothermal area, home to the famous Strokkur geyser, which erupts every 4–8 minutes and shoots an impressive column of water up to 30 meters high.

Next, we will discover the majestic Gullfoss waterfall, where the Hvítá River plunges in two stages into a deep canyon, creating an unforgettable natural spectacle.

At the end of the tour, we will continue to Hella. Arrival and check-in at the hotel.

The route continues to the black-sand beach of Reynisfjara, known for its striking basalt columns and the powerful waves of the North Atlantic, and ends in the charming village of Vík. An unforgettable experience that reveals the pure and untamed beauty of Iceland's landscape.

Reykjavík (translated as "Smokey Bay"), the capital of Iceland, is the world's northernmost capital, with a population of approximately 123,000. The coastline of the Reykjavík area is characterised by peninsulas, coves, straits, and islands.

During a panoramic city tour, you will enjoy a pleasant walk through the city centre, passing by City Hall, Reykjavík's oldest church—Dómkirkjan—and the building of the Icelandic Parliament, known as Alþingi. From here, we continue past Hallgrímskirkja Church, one of Iceland's most iconic and instantly recognisable landmarks, whose architecture evokes scenes reminiscent of The Lord of the Rings.

You will also admire the impressive contemporary structure of Reykjavík's Harpa Concert Hall, a true must-see.

The experience continues in Arnarstapi, where cliffs, rock formations, and seabirds provide spectacular views over the Atlantic Ocean. Next, the volcanic beach of Djúpalónssandur, with remnants of ancient shipwrecks, leads to the impressive lava towers of Lóndrangar rising from the coastline. The route then continues toward the majestic Snæfells-jökull glacier-volcano, which inspired Journey to the Center of the Earth, before visiting the iconic Mount Kirkjufell, one of Iceland’s most photographed mountains. On the return to Reykjavik, the journey passes through the Berserkjahraun lava field and concludes with a relaxing stop at the Hvammsvík thermal baths.

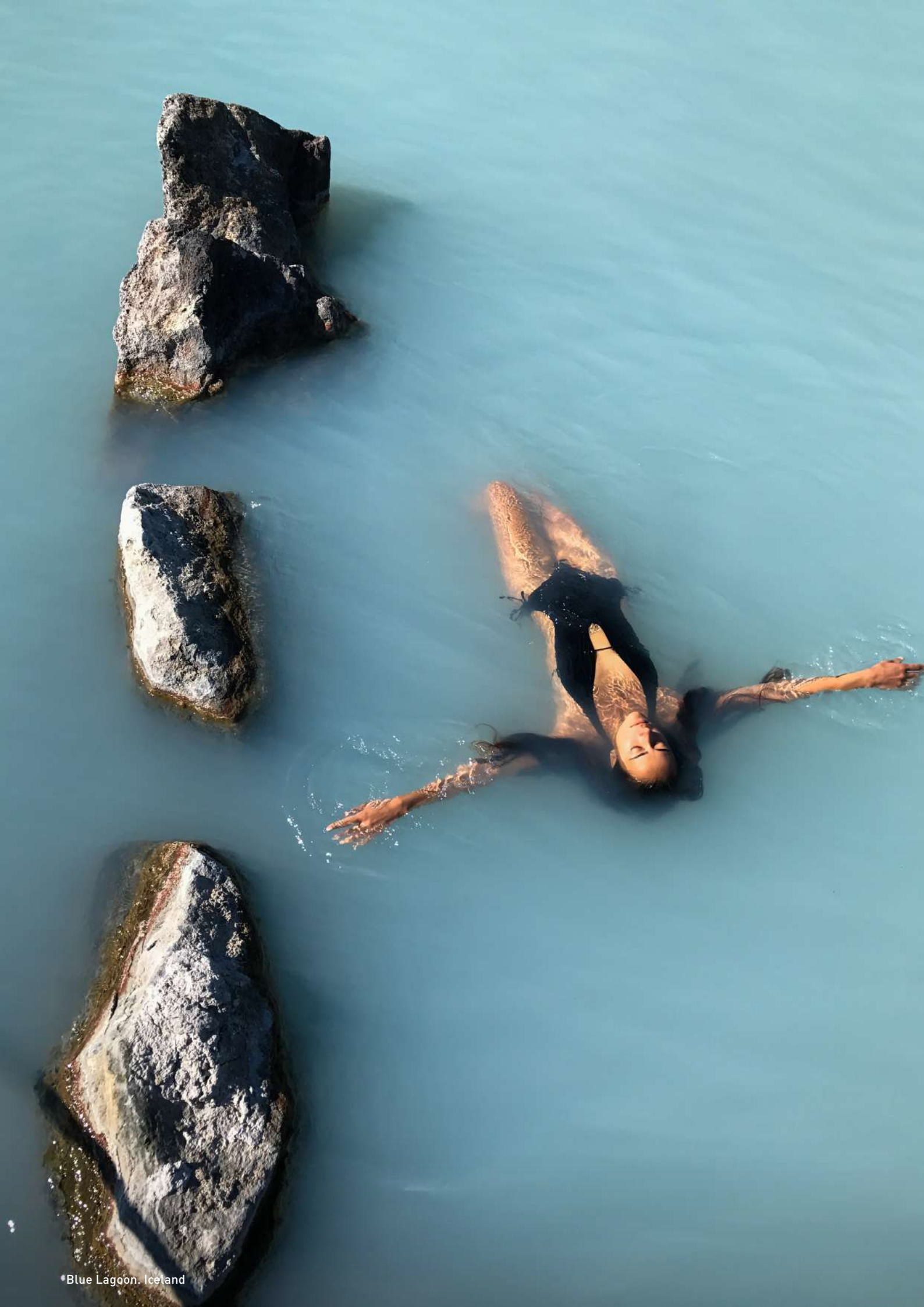

belius Monument.

The name “Koiteli” comes from the Sámi language and means “in the middle.” In this unique location, guests will enjoy a charming and memorable dining experience

on an island nestled between two rapids. Guests are welcomed into a cozy cabin with a large fire-place, ideal for relaxing and enjoying a delicious three-course dinner. During the evening, the guide will share insights into Finnish nature, the Koiteli area, and the fascinating Northern Lights phenomenon. After dinner, there will be an excellent opportunity to observe and search for the Northern Lights with the assistance of a professional guide. The area is quiet and features very low light pollution, making it an ideal location for both viewing and photographing the auroras.

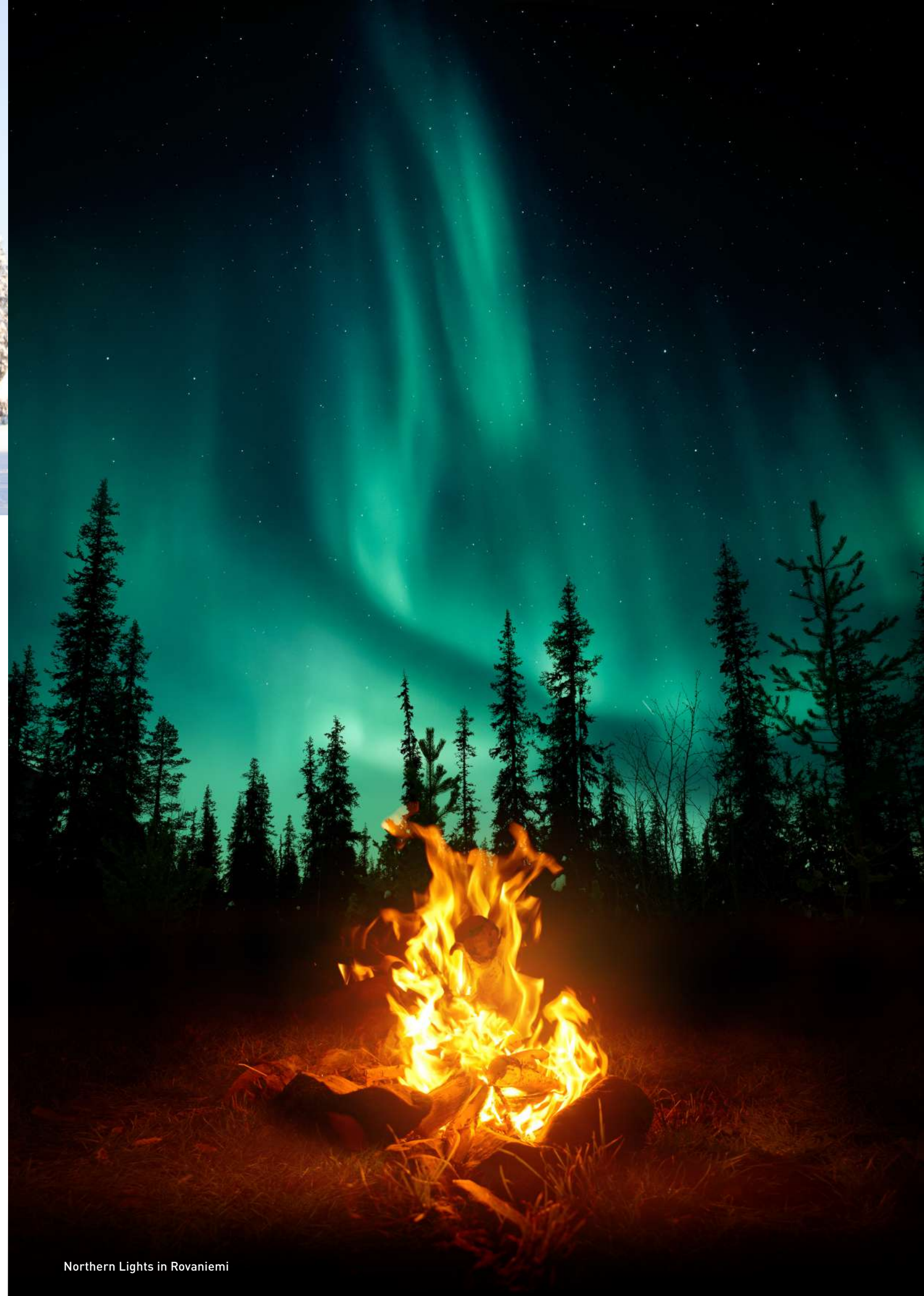

9) CHILD POLICY

Borealis DMC is not responsible for the lack of suitable equipment or facilities

adapted to the needs of underage passengers. Winter in Iceland: from 8 years old. Christmas in Lapland: from 4 years old. Arctic Wonders Christmas Markets and Northern Lights: 6 years old. 10) IMPORTANT NOTE

It is important to note that in all our programs there may be a slight physical demand, and the passenger may be exposed to different types of physical effort. Uneven terrain during walking tours and surfaces in some places snow and ice are common in our destinations. All activities related to boating, snowmobiling, reindeer sledding, dog sledding, igloo dinners, and icebreakers will include appropriate thermal equipment. However, it is mandatory that all passengers have appropriate clothing and footwear for arctic temperatures.

11) CLAIMS AND IRREGULARITIES

Any claim must be submitted in writing within four weeks of the end date of the trip. Borealis DMC responds to all claims relating to breach of contract within eight days of receipt. Subjective claims, such as activities not carried out due to climatic impediments, etc., will not be considered. We strongly recommend all passengers and collaborators to report any irregularities immediately to their accompanying guide or to our headquarters in Copenhagen. Refunds and compensation will only occur in the event of contrac-

tual irregularities / non-provision of the service that have been reported during the passengers' stay at the destination.
